COLUMBUS, Miss. - Mississippi University for Women will be doing its part in contributing to "Loaves and Fishes" and "Global Connections" by making bowls for the "Empty Bowls for Hunger" event.

There will be three opportunities to make bowls on the MUW campus for the "Empty Bowls for Hunger" event, which is hosted by the MUW Department of Art and Design, the MUW Culinary Arts Institute and the Shops at Brickerton.

MUW faculty will get some instruction from Holen on wheel throwing, hand building, and using molds. This will take place Thursday, Oct. 22, from 4 p.m. to 8 p.m.

Participants will make the bowls in room 100 of the MUW Art and Design Building.

All bowls made will be sold at the "Empty Bowls for Hunger" event on Saturday, Nov. 7, on the front lawn at the Shops at Brickerton. All proceeds will go to "Loaves and Fishes" here in Columbus and "Global Connections," an organization that alleviates hunger and brings other relief to the people of Africa.
